

Costa Rica Adventure Trip. May 16th – 22nd 2010

Join us for an Adventure filled trip to the wonderful Central American country of Costa Rica. The first part of our adventure will take us kayaking on the Northeast area of Costa Rica's Caribbean Coast. We will stay at the Mawamba Lodge situated on a sand bar between the Tortuguero Canals and the Caribbean Sea, an excellent location that provides direct access to the beach and the canals. Nestled in the lush rainforest, this is the ideal hideaway for nature lovers and the perfect place to discover the wonders of the Tortuguero National Park in a unique system of natural and man-made canals used for transportation and exploration. Admire exceptional flora and fauna including orchids, birds, monkeys, crocodiles, toucans, etc. in their natural habitat from a kayak or the trail.

The adventure will then move inland to do some river rafting and spend two nights in the rainforest lodge. There are only two ways to get to the Lodge, ride a raft down the river through the rapids or hike in through the forest. We will be taking the raft in. There's plenty to do at the lodge you can choose to experience zip lines through the canopy, rainforest hikes with naturalist guides, tours to reforestation project and tree-planting, horseback riding to a local community with tours of their sustainable farming and conservation practices, relaxing in a hammock overlooking the warm Pacuare River, reading your favorite book, or bird watching. The best whitewater of the trip awaits you below the Rios Tropicales Lodge. From the eco-lodge enjoy tropical cocktails every afternoon at 5, open air dining with wine and exceptional meals, more stars than you can imagine, and the vibrant sounds of the jungle.
